Taos is a unique small town in northern New Mexico's high desert at 7,000 feet. Bounded by the Sangre de Cristo Mountains, the Rio Lucero to the north and the Rio Grande de Ranchos to the south, Taos is known for its striking landscape, adobe architecture, artists and art galleries and blend of 3 cultures - Native American, Spanish and Anglo.
